



Evidencing the impact of Primary PE and Sport Premium 2020-2021

It is expected that schools will see an improvement against the following 5 key indicators

- The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity, kick starting healthy active lifestyles.
- The profile of PE and sport being raised across the school as a tool for whole school improvement
- Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport
- Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils
- Increased participation in competitive sport

Purpose of the sports grant:

To achieve self-sustaining improvement in the quality of PE and sport in primary schools.

To promote an awareness of the importance of healthy lifestyles.

To have a broad range of coverage for all skill areas across both Key Stages.

To develop a consistent approach to assessment of the skills across the school, with an emphasis on supporting evidence.

In March 2020 the global Corona Virus Pandemic meant that primary schools had to close to all but Key Worker and Vulnerable pupils. This impacted on spending plans of the 2019-2020 sports grant. The surplus has been carried forward into 2020-2021 and will be evidenced in this overview by March 2021.
