Dear Parents and Carers

Over the last two weeks lots of you have asked about sending items into school such as Christmas cards. Children will be allowed to bring cards into school for their friends, but we will be doing this differently due to the restrictions that are in place. We would ask that children bring their cards into school in their card box or in a bag that is labelled with their name and place them in the designated card collection box in their classroom. Within school we will have one set morning/afternoon which will be the 14th of December where cards will be given out in class. Children can start to bring their cards in from Monday the 7th to put in their class box and the last day for bringing them in will be Friday the 11th of December so that they ready for handing out on Monday the 14th.

Our most recent newsletter outlined the Christmas activities taking place in school, such as our class Christmas parties in the final week, Christmas dinner, digital pantomime viewing on the 11th and our Evening Christmas Family Sing Along with Mrs Geelan on the 16th of December. More specific details about these activities will be sent out next week.

We know that at this time of year children often want to thank their adults in school for their support and as a staff we are always overwhelmed by the lovely gestures from families. As restrictions still remain in place we would encourage you not to send gifts into school, but if children and families would like to give their adults cards, this can be done through the process outlined above, as children will be able to put any cards/messages for their adults in their class collection box right up until the final day of term.
