Medical Tracker

Next week, we are introducing a new way of recording medical information and accidents/ injuries, via a computer system called 'Medical Tracker'. This system will enable us to record incidents electronically and monitor them more effectively. The main difference that you will see is that if your child has an accident in school, you will receive an email notification, instead of your child bringing home an accident slip. We will still telephone parents in the event of a head injury or a more serious injury or illness where a child may need to be collected.
