Spelling Frame ~ Dyslexic friendly games

On the SpellingFrame home page, there is a SITE COLOURS button. Here you can choose to select 'Dyslexia Friendly' colours for your screen. This will change some of the colour schemes within the games to be more supportive for the children, including varying colours for sounds within **the practice tests**. SpellingFrame is recommended on the Dyslexia Assist website:

In addition to the practice tests, Dyslexia friendly games on SpellingFrame focus more on breaking words into syllables and sound cards. Children are encouraged to learn each syllable at a time and use these strategies to build entire words.

Segment Cards

Watch and listen as each word in the list is broken into either syllables or phonemes and sounded out.
