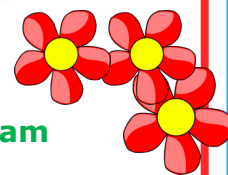

All children in Pankhurst can come to school in their own clothes on **Friday 19th April.**

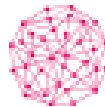

Century Tech is created using artificial intelligence and it is intuitive, creating a personal pathway of learning for your child. Teachers will set weekly nuggets for children to complete. A nugget will take between 2 and 10 minutes to complete.

Please encourage your child and help them to access this platform at home. They have all logged in during learning time and know how to navigate it. There have been a number of children that have logged on during the Easter break and started to complete nuggets of learning. Well done!

At Unsworth, we ask you to focus on the **SMART** areas. Spelling, Maths and Reading at home together. These basic skills are so important to practice at home together. Little and often—a few times a week. In Reception and Year 1—we also share the Supersonic Friends Phonics newsletter so you know the sounds your child is working on in school.
