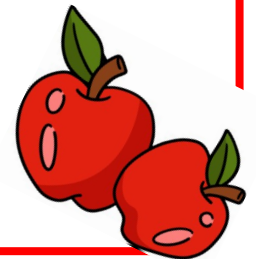


Nut Free School
