92% of parents attended!

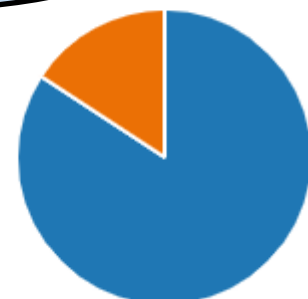

Free School Meals, which is one category for Pupil Premium Funding

If you're eligible it means in KS2 your child gets a free school meal, but it also means we get additional funding to spend in school.

Your child may be able to get free school meals if you get any of the following:

- Universal Credit with a household income of less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)
- Income-Based Jobseekers' Allowance
- Income-Related Employment and Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit, **not** entitled to Working Tax Credit and household income less than £16,190
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Income Support
- Working Tax Credit 'run on' – the payment you receive for a further four weeks after you finish work

You can also claim Pupil Premium funding if your child is, or was previously looked after by a local authority. If this is the case, and you don't mind, please call into the office and inform myself or Mrs Hutchinson.

This table shows how the pupil premium grant is allocated to schools and local authorities in financial year 2023-24, based on per pupil rates.

Thank you for supporting this day! The children enjoyed a fun filled maths day!

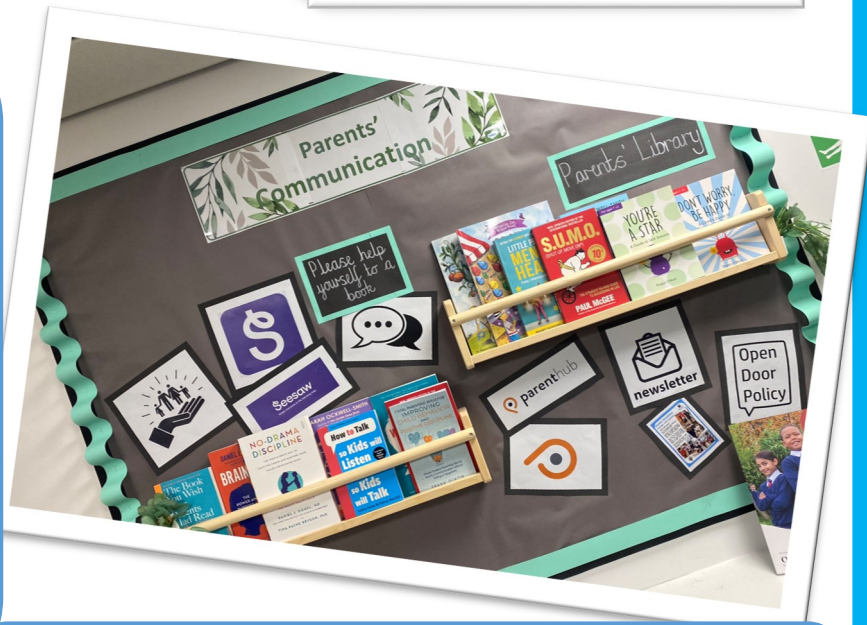


Our Parents' Library
