Attendance

We have seen a huge reduction in our 'Persistent Absence' figures in school. Persistent absence is when a child's attendance is less than 90%. That means they are missing at least one day a fortnight.

The national average figure for persistent absenteeism is 15.6%. At Unsworth, we have reduced to 8.4% from 9.3% last year. Thank you to all parents and carers for supporting us with attendance.

If your child's attendance falls close to 90%, we will write to you and invite you in for a meeting.

Being absent from school means children miss out on friendships, developing their social skills and keeping up with their academic learning.

We know there will be times when children are unwell or have important family or religious events to attend.
