





Welcome to SeeSaw

Dear Parents/Carers,

We will be using an online learning journal called Seesaw to record and document part of your child's learning across school. Seesaw is a web-based tool that can be accessed via a computer or laptop and on any Android or Apple device such as a Smartphone or tablet.

Seesaw enables us to upload photos of your child, the Seesaw app will then alert you that something new has been added to your child's learning journal. In addition, you can then instantly add your own comments and can show your child's learning journal to members of your family.

Safeguarding children at school is very important to us. Everything that is added to Seesaw will be on our school account and can only be viewed by school staff that use the system and yourself, using your own log in details. You will only have access to your child's learning journal and this cannot be seen by other parents. In addition, it is crucial that you do not share photos or videos from your child's learning journal on social media or through any other online platforms. Any incidents where this confidentiality is broken will be dealt with seriously and may result in access to the service being withdrawn.

In addition to viewing our contributions, we encourage you to add to it by uploading photos and comments, or home learning from home. Seesaw creates a triangle of communication between not only you as parents with the teachers but also with the children too. It encourages technological literacy in a safe and creative way.

As children progress and move through school their Seesaw account will stay with them and they will begin to take greater ownership of it and taught how to upload images themselves.

Your child will be given codes to access different areas of Seesaw. Child Code: This code allows them to upload learning and access the activity section.

Family code: Will not allow you to upload work. This is for parents to see, like and comment on their child's work.

Codes will be sent home next week.
