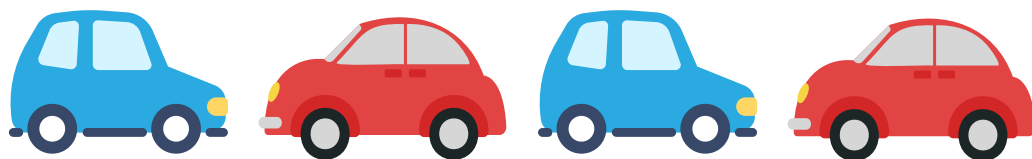
This week Y6 foraged for sticks then used peelers to whittle the wood to use to toast marshmallows on the fire.
