Reception had an exciting first outing as part of their learning about The Gingerbread Man. The children walked to Martin's Bakery, where they each purchased their own gingerbread biscuit and showed excellent manners throughout. They returned safely, full of smiles and stories!

One of the things we are most proud of at Unsworth is the high-quality teaching and learning our children experience across a broad and balanced curriculum. This week, Year 6 impressed us with their Food Technology project, creating homemade wholemeal bread and a fresh pasta sauce using herbs and tomatoes. They learned valuable skills in planning, preparing, and cooking a complete meal.

Year 4 have been developing their weaving techniques in Design Technology, while Year 5 continued their exploration of the Earth, Moon, and Space. Using a tennis ball and a dodgeball, they modelled the Earth's rotation and orbit around the Sun, helping them understand why we have day and night and the changing seasons.

Finally, a big well done to our Year 6 netball team, who represented Unsworth brilliantly at Philips High School on Friday evening!
