Parents Evening Feedback

A big thank you to all parents who completed our Parents' Evening feedback form. We are delighted to hear so many positive comments, including personal messages for staff, which have been shared with them. Overall, almost everyone found the booking process straightforward and felt the evening ran smoothly. A few parents mentioned that some appointments did not run exactly to time. We always strive to keep to schedule, but occasionally discussions can take longer than expected. Thank you for your understanding.

We would also like to address three specific points raised:

Challenge for All Children

One parent expressed concern that we only focus on children working below age-related expectations. This is not the case. Our KS2 SATs results demonstrate that we challenge all pupils:

- 82% achieved age-related expectations (20% above the national average).
- Children attaining Greater Depth in all areas (except writing) were well above national figures.
- o 36% achieved the higher standard in maths and reading.
- These outcomes reflect our commitment to high expectations for every child.

Appointment Times

Another comment suggested that appointments had moved exclusively to afternoons. While some families prefer this option, late appointments were available for all classes on Monday evening until 7pm. We aim to balance being accessible for working families with ensuring staff can return home after a long day.

Seating Arrangements

A parent mentioned the small chairs used during meetings. If you require an adult-sized chair for future appointments, please email us in advance and we will gladly accommodate.
