Building Work and Reduced Parking

We will shortly be carrying out essential remedial work in our Reception and Year 1 classrooms due to a water leak beneath the flooring. The rooms need to be repaired and fully dried, and this is not work that can be completed during the school holidays.

To ensure learning continues as normal, Reception and Year 1 will move into temporary classrooms positioned on the playground, over on the basketball courts. These will be delivered during the Easter break, and children will begin using them after the holiday.

The temporary units have been arranged through our insurance companies and will be fully equipped to a high standard, including age-appropriate facilities.

During the summer term, there will be reduced parking on the school site while the building compound is in place. This will take up part of the parent parking area. During this time, we kindly ask for everyone's patience. If you are able to park safely on the road and walk a little further, please do so—this will really help ease congestion and keep everyone safe.
