Year 6 Coaching Groups

This year we have introduced Coaching Groups to Year 6.

Our fantastic Year 6 coaching groups have had an incredibly successful half term, with coaching becoming a powerful driver for helping pupils take ownership of their learning and preparing them confidently for the transition to high school. Each week, children work within their coaching teams—Team Grundy, Team Ali, Team Turner, Team Marshall, —aiming to progress from bronze through to platinum on the coaching rubric.

During sessions, team leaders celebrate achievements, review progress and support pupils in setting clear next steps, while children also coach one another by sharing ideas and offering advice.

To make the most of the programme, pupils are expected to be self-motivated, complete their home learning through platforms such as Century Tech, Spelling Frame and Seesaw, or record tasks in their coaching books.
