For PE, children should wear:

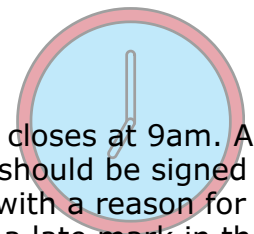
- Plain black leggings, joggers or shorts

KS2 ~ Egg Decorating

- Please **do not** send in any super glue or adhesive sprays as glue will be available for children to use.
- Please do not send paint - **paint will be provided**.
