Before & After School Club

We know that the introduction of our new booking system has created some extra work for families and we would like to thank you for your patience as we continue to refine and improve the process. Change can take time to get used to, and we appreciate your support whilst we make further adjustments and refinements to ease the system.

The new system provides greater flexibility for families who need different session patterns and allows children to attend extracurricular clubs without families having to pay for an additional before or after school club session around the activity.

A reminder of the booking arrangements:

- ★ Payments must be made before completing any bookings.
- ★ You can register your child for Daily Club and then select the individual days you wish to book.
- ★ Sessions must be booked at least seven days in advance.
- ★ Emergency bookings made after the booking cut-off are charged at £6 per hour.
